### DENTAL RESIDENCY OR SPECIALTY PROGRAM FUNDED BY COLGATE-PALMOLIVE COMPANY

Maximum award: \$5,000 for Dental Residency students.

Maximum award: \$4,500 for 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year Dental Students.
